The total racing experience for ALL the family, where picking winners is only half the fun! In 2010 we have a fantastic range of themed racedays and entertainment at the Sporting Heart of Cumbria. Don't forget **kids under 16 go FREE** to all race meetings when accompanied by an adult (please note that for concert events children may be charged £5 to view the concert).

Grandstand & Paddock Tickets enable you to visit all ground floor public areas including the Bell Hall of the Edinburgh Woollen Mill Grandstand with its extensive bars and fast food outlets, the Red Rum Bar, Champagne and Seafood Bar, Silks Café, Parade Ring and Pre-Parade Ring.

Premier Badges (includes an official programme) give you the added bonus of being able to use the first floor and upper terraces of the Edinburgh Woollen Mill Grandstand, the Patterson Bar, Premier Patio Bar and the Swifts Restaurant. The dress code for the Premier Enclosure is smart casual.

The Swifts Restaurant on the first floor of the Edinburgh Woollen Mill Grandstand offers an excellent view of the racing and a first class dining experience. Tables can be reserved for the day and include Premier badge, official programme, three-course lunch and afternoon tea for just £60 per person (£65 on feature days). Must be booked and paid for in advance.

Families and Children are always welcome at the races and for children under 16 years of age, accompanied by an adult, admission is FREE. Baby changing facilities are available in both the Grandstand & Paddock and Premier Enclosures. Children's entertainments and a Crèche are arranged for certain meetings including on all family days. Big Screen Viewing The Big Screen is in operation on all racedays for 2010.

Disabled Racegoers may take advantage of a designated parking area and a viewing platform on the first floor of the Edinburgh Woollen Mill Grandstand. Premier badges are required (at Grandstand & Paddock price) and a complimentary badge will be provided to the accompanying carer.

Parking There is a free public car park opposite the Main Grandstand. Alternatively there is Trackside Car Park for £10 per vehicle (£5 on Family days), which is located alongside the racetrack. Coach parking is free.

How To Find Us

From the North or South

Come off at junction 42 of the M6. Follow signs for Dalston. Follow the road for approx 2 miles until you reach a staggered junction and turn right. The Racecourse is approximately half a mile on the left hand side.

From the East

Take the A69 or A66 to the M6 motorway. Join the M6 and come off at junction 42 and follow directions above.

From the West

Travel along the A595 following signs for Carlisle. Approx 1 mile after Thursby roundabout take the right signposted for Dalston (Peter Lane). At the T junction in Dalston turn right. Follow the road until reaching the Bridge End pub. Turn left over the bridge and follow the signs for Durdar. When you reach the next junction turn left. The Racecourse is approx half a mile on the left hand side.

By Rail

To Carlisle Station, Stagecoach (01228 597222) operate a bus service to Durdar – Route 66. Alternatively the Racecourse is only a short taxi ride away.

By Air

Carlisle Airport is approximately eight miles from the Racecourse. Helicopter landing at the Racecourse is by prior arrangement only.
